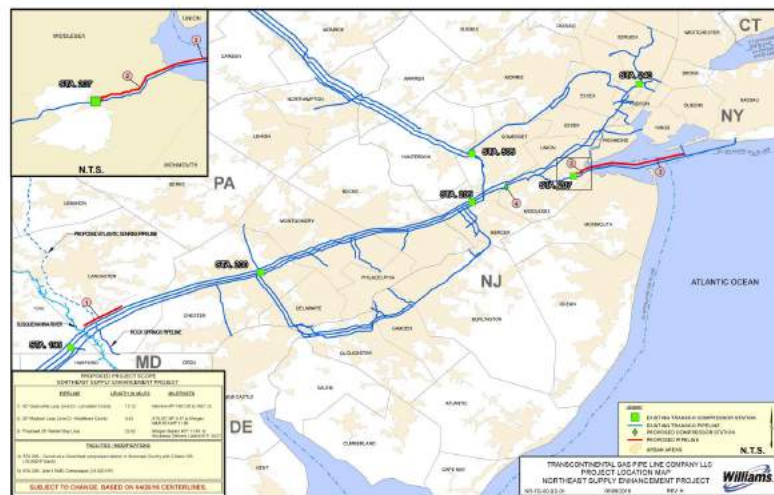

The Public Comment Period for Williams Pipeline is Open!



Williams Transco has proposed a 23.4-mile pipeline project to expand its existing Transco transmission system to transport natural gas from the Marcellus Shale region through Raritan Bay to New York. If built, the pipeline will disrupt YOUR fishing, boating, and recreational activities! Construction of the pipeline would also disturb habitat for clams, horseshoe
